AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending Section 3, Chapter 7, O.S.L. 1992 (21 O.S. Supp. 1993, Section 1040.77), which relates to penalties for displaying materials harmful to minors; modifying language; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 7, O.S.L. 1992 (21 O.S. Supp. 1993, Section 1040.77), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1040.77 Any person convicted of violating any provision of Section ~~2~~ 1040.76 of this ~~act~~ title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each day that any violation of Section ~~2~~ 1040.76 of this ~~act~~ title occurs or continues shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as a separate violation. Every act or transaction prohibited by Section ~~2~~ 1040.76 of this ~~act~~ title shall constitute a separate offense as to each item, issue or title involved and shall be punishable as such. For the purpose of this section, multiple copies of the same identical title, monthly issue, volume and number issue or other such identical material shall constitute a single offense.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
