AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to guardianship; requiring certain divisions within the Department of Human Services to provide guardianship services to certain persons; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-106.1 of Title 30, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Persons eligible for services pursuant to the Protective Services for the Elderly and for Incapacitated Adults Act, Section 10-101 et seq. of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be eligible for guardianship services to be provided by the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Services.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-105.1 of Title 30, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A child determined to be dependent shall be eligible for guardianship services to be provided by the Child Welfare Division of the Department of Human Services. Such guardianship services shall be provided at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
