AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public records and information;  
making appropriations to the Secretary of State;  
stating purposes; setting certain limits; making  
appropriations to the State Department of  
Libraries; stating purposes; setting certain  
limits; providing lapse dates; providing an  
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Two Hundred Forty-three Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-three Dollars (\$243,663.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-nine Dollars (\$10,959.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for Personal

Services. Funds appropriated by this section may be budgeted and expended only after the agency has complied with the provisions for implementing the FY-95 State Salary Pay Increase Plan.

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law shall be set by the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and Total Expenditures for Operations, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

Full-time-equivalent Employees	41.0
Total Expenditures for Operations	\$2,240,574.00

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Four Million Three Hundred Forty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-one Dollars (\$4,345,781.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-six Dollars (\$25,726.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for Personal Services. Funds appropriated by this section may be budgeted and expended only after the agency has complied with the provisions for implementing the FY-95 State Salary Pay Increase Plan.

SECTION 6. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the Director. The Oklahoma Department of Libraries, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, salary of the Director, and Total Expenditures for Operations, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

Maximum Salary of the Director	\$52,227.00
Full-time-equivalent Employees	81.8
Total Expenditures for Operations	\$6,527,533.00

SECTION 7. The appropriations made in this act may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995 (hereafter FY-95) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996 (hereafter FY-96). Funds budgeted for FY-95 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1995 and must be expended by November 15, 1995. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1995, and not budgeted for FY-96, will lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-96 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1996. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1996 will lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-95 and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year may be budgeted for FY-96 after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-95 budget and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
