An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 377.1, which relates to the Department of Public Safety Communications Division; requiring that certain plans for communication sites or dispatch offices be submitted for approval by the Legislature; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 377.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 377.1 ~~(a)~~ A. There is hereby established in the Department of Public Safety a division to be known as the Department of Public Safety Communications Division. This division shall be divided into a Dispatchers Bureau and a Technicians Bureau and such other bureaus as the Commissioner may direct.

~~(b)~~ B. In order to be eligible for employment to the positions of Director of the Communications Division, Communications Officer, Radio Technician, Radio Dispatcher and Tower Maintenance Officer included in the Public Safety Communications Division, a person shall be a citizen of Oklahoma; shall be of good moral character; shall possess a high school education or the equivalent thereof; and shall pass such physical and mental examinations as the Commissioner may prescribe.

C. Before the Department of Public Safety may add or change any communication site or dispatch office, the Commissioner of Public Safety shall submit a plan for approval by the Legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
