An Act relating to waste and the environment;
amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-2005.3B, as
last amended by Section 7 of Enrolled Senate
Bill No. 1 of the 1st Session of the 44th
Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to disposal
fees for liquid waste in underground injection
wells; modifying disposal fee; requiring fees to
be deposited in certain fund; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-2005.3B,
as last amended by Section 7 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1 of the
1st Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
follows:

Section 1-2005.3B Any person subject to regulation under this
title subject to regulation by the Department of Environmental
Quality disposing of liquid waste other than hazardous waste in an
underground injection well shall pay a fee of ~~five-hundredths of one
cent (\$0.0005)~~ two hundredths of one cent (\$0.0002) per gallon for
such disposal, provided that the total fee shall be not less than
~~Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00)~~ Ten Thousand Dollars
(\$10,000.00) nor more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per
year. Said fee shall be paid to the Department on a quarterly basis
within one (1) month following the close of each quarter for the
waste disposed in that preceding quarter. Said fees shall be
deposited into the ~~Public Health Special~~ Department of Environmental
Quality Revolving Fund.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1993.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
