An Act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing Corporation Commission to promulgate rules enabling participation in single state registration system for motor carriers pursuant to the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991; authorizing Corporation Commission to apply rules and regulations to interstate motor carriers exempt from the Interstate Commerce Commission regulations; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 162.1 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Corporation Commission is authorized to promulgate all rules and regulations necessary to enable the State of Oklahoma to participate in the single state registration system for motor carriers authorized by the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991, 49 U.S.C., Section 11506 (1991), and by applicable rules and regulations of the Interstate Commerce Commission.

B. The Corporation Commission is authorized to apply rules and regulations to interstate motor carriers exempt from the Interstate Commerce Commission regulations.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
