An Act relating to bonds; appropriating the proceeds of the sale of bonds authorized by Section 43 of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; stating purposes; appropriating certain funds and providing for deposit of such funds; requiring bonds be issued and sold under certain constitutional grant of power; making appropriations to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the University of Oklahoma, the University of Oklahoma - Health Sciences Center, Oklahoma State University, Oklahoma State University Technical Branch - Okmulgee, Oklahoma State University - Veterinary Medicine, Oklahoma State University Technical Branch - Oklahoma City, Oklahoma State University - College of Osteopathic Medicine, the University of Central Oklahoma, East Central University, Northeastern State University, Northwestern Oklahoma State University, Southeastern Oklahoma State University, Southwestern Oklahoma State University, Cameron University, Langston University, Oklahoma Panhandle State University, the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma, the University Center at Tulsa, Carl Albert State College, Connors State College, Eastern Oklahoma State College, Murray State College, Northeastern Oklahoma A & M College, Northern Oklahoma College, Oklahoma City Community College, Redlands Community College, Rogers State College, Rose State College, Seminole Junior College, Tulsa Junior College, Western Oklahoma State College, the Enid Higher Education Program, the Ardmore Higher Education Program, higher education facilities at Muskogee, and the Idabel (McCurtain County) Higher Education Program; making appropriations to the State Department of Vocational and Technical Education, the Board of Trustees of the School of Science and Mathematics, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Department of Libraries, the Department of Corrections, the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the State Department of Health, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, the

State Department of Agriculture, the Department of Central Services, the Legislative Service Bureau, the Office of State Finance, the Department of Mental Health, and the Department of Human Services; authorizing institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education to refinance certain debt; removing requirement of concurrent resolution; amending 70 O.S. 1991, Section 4002.1, which relates to legislative approval for the issuance of certain bonds; creating exception; restricting expenditure of funds to specified purposes; requiring budget submittals; requiring legislative appropriation of certain funds; restricting transfer of funds; authorizing payment of certain costs associated with issuance of bonds from certain accounts; authorizing the use of funds appropriated to obtain federal aid assistance; requiring Director of the Office of State Finance to develop certain forms and procedures for cash draws; authorizing the Director of the Office of State Finance to transfer certain funds for certain purpose; directing the State Treasurer to invest certain monies under certain conditions; amending Section 7, Chapter 350, O.S.L. 1992 (62 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 57.306), which relates to Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund; transferring certain duties; amending Section 2, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 1992 (62 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 41.5n), which relates to the State Data Processing and Telecommunications Advisory Committee; adding members to the Committee; setting requirements for a quorum; providing for travel reimbursement; requiring approval of recommendations; authorizing the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to refinance certain obligations; authorizing the retention of legal counsel; making appropriations nonfiscal; stating lapse period; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared that the purposes of this act are to provide for appropriation of the proceeds of the sale of bonds to be issued and sold pursuant to the provisions of Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution and the Oklahoma Building Bond and College Savings Bond Act, Section 57.300 et seq. of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes and to provide for the efficient administration of capital expenditures in this state.

SECTION 2. The appropriations made by this act are appropriated from the proceeds of the sale of bonds issued and sold pursuant to the provisions of Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution and the Oklahoma Building Bond and College Savings Bond Act, Section 57.300 et seq. of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A), in

the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B) and in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury.

SECTION 3. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the University of Oklahoma from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A) in the State Treasury the sum of Twenty Million Three Hundred Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Two Dollars (\$20,316,602.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures.

SECTION 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that funds appropriated in Section 3 of this act be allocated for the following projects and in the following amounts:

SECTION 5. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the University of Oklahoma - Health Sciences Center from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A) in the State Treasury the sum of Twelve Million Six Hundred Sixty-one Thousand Eighty Dollars (\$12,661,080.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that funds appropriated in Section 5 of this act be allocated for the following projects and in the following amounts:

Oklahoma State University from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A) in the State Treasury the sum of Nine Million Eight Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$9,828,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures. It is the intent of the Legislature that the funds appropriated in this section be expended for the College of Education.

SECTION 8. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Oklahoma State University from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A) in the State Treasury the sum of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for renovation of the Agriculture Experiment Station.

SECTION 9. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Oklahoma State University - Technical Branch, Okmulgee, from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A) in the State Treasury the sum of Two Million Two Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Six Hundred Two Dollars (\$2,221,602.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures.

SECTION 10. It is the intent of the Legislature that funds appropriated in Section 9 of this act be allocated for the following projects and in the following amounts:

As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Oklahoma State University - Technical Branch, Okmulgee, from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B) in the State Treasury the sum of One Million Eight Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$1,896,398.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures.

As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Southwestern Oklahoma State University from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B) in the State Treasury the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures. It is the intent of the Legislature that the funds appropriated in this section be expended for telecommunications equipment.

SECTION 90. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Carl Albert State College from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B) in the State Treasury the sum of One Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$148,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures. It is the intent of the Legislature that the funds appropriated in this section be expended for equipment purchases.

SECTION 91. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Connors State College from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B) in the State Treasury the sum of Forty-five Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$45,100.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B) in the State Treasury the sum of Two Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$257,500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase of a computer programming/mapper system.

SECTION 113. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the University of Oklahoma from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Four Million Six Hundred Sixty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$4,669,898.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for equipping, remodeling,

SECTION 115. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Oklahoma State University from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing, equipping, remodeling, modernizing and repair of buildings, and for other capital expenditures. It is the intent of the Legislature that the funds appropriated in this section be expended for the Advanced Technology Center.

SECTION 116. As required by Section 55 of Article V and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for Oklahoma State University from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Five Million Four Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$5,401,770.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of a Food Processing Research Center located in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

SECTION 117. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of State Finance from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for telecommunications as recommended by the State Data Processing and Telecommunications Advisory Committee.

SECTION 118. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of funding by contract the construction, acquisition, repair or improvement of infrastructure works to conserve and develop water resources within the state.

SECTION 119. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for a drug offender work camp and capital improvements at statewide correctional facilities.

SECTION 120. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Mental Health from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in the State Treasury the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction, furnishing and equipping of new buildings, for equipping, remodeling, modernizing

and repairing existing buildings, and for other capital expenditures for the Center for Pregnant Women with Substance Abuse located in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 121. Any institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education is hereby authorized to refinance any outstanding debt between the effective date of this act and June 30, 1994, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Bond Oversight and Reform Act.

SECTION 122. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 4002.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4002.1 Legislative approval expressed by concurrent resolution, except as provided by Section 121 of this act, shall be required prior to commencing any action in anticipation of issuance by a Board of Regents of revenue bonds authorized by Section 4002 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes or any other bonds authorized by law to be issued by such Boards.

SECTION 123. Funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for the projects and subject to the spending limits specified in this act and for no other purpose. Institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and executive agencies expending funds appropriated by this act shall provide to the Office of State Finance a budget for each project specified in this act. Funds not necessary for the completion of a project specified in this act shall not be expended for any other purpose without a specific appropriation by the Legislature pursuant to Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution and Section 57.303 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The appropriations made by this act shall not be transferred as provided by the provisions of Section 41.12 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes unless specifically authorized by the Contingency Review Board.

SECTION 124. The Oklahoma Building Bonds Commission is hereby authorized to pay the costs associated with the issuance of bonds from agency special accounts created pursuant to Section 7.2 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Allowable payments from said accounts shall include, but not be limited to, administrative, legal, printing, travel, postage and other costs associated with the issuance of bonds as approved by the Commission.

SECTION 125. Any funds appropriated in this act may be used and expended in conjunction or in cooperation with any federal agency or instrumentality under such terms and conditions as may be necessary to obtain grants of federal assistance for the project for which the funds were appropriated.

SECTION 126. The Director of the Office of State Finance shall develop forms and procedures for cash draws against appropriations out of the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Funds. Said procedures shall include but not be limited to the following:

1. Agencies shall not request funds until they are programmed for expenditure pursuant to a schedule developed by the Office of State Finance based on information provided by the Oklahoma Building Bonds Commission and until appropriate claims are ready to be submitted to the Director of the Office of State Finance for processing;

2. Upon receipt and approval of agency requests for funds, the Director of the Office of State Finance shall notify the State Treasurer to make sufficient funds available the next business day to cover the agency draws. The State Treasurer shall notify the Director of the Office of State Finance if there is an insufficient investment balance in the cash investment account to cover the draws; and

3. Agencies shall notify the Director of the Office of State Finance of any funds that have been transferred that will not be expended within ten (10) days. The Director of the Office of State Finance shall transfer said funds back to the unallocated pool and notify the State Treasurer to reinvest same.

SECTION 127. Any monies accruing to a fund specified in this act in excess of the amount appropriated may be transferred to any other fund specified by this act by the Director of State Finance as needed to meet the appropriations from such other fund. This section does not authorize the Director to alter the amount specified for any project identified in this act or to change the funding source for any purpose other than that allowed by this section.

SECTION 128. The State Treasurer is hereby directed to invest the monies in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A), the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (B), and the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (C) in accordance with the provisions of Section 89.2 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 129. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 350, O.S.L. 1992 (62 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 57.306), is amended to read as follows:

Section 57.306 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury of the State of Oklahoma the "Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund". The proceeds of the sale of bonds pursuant to this act shall be deposited in said fund, where they shall remain subject to disposition to be provided for by the Legislature of this state, provided that the State Treasurer, when so directed by the Commission, shall invest the amounts designated by the Commission for the period of time specified by the Commission; provided that all such investments of said monies must be made so that the same shall mature in time to enable the State of Oklahoma to issue warrants for payment of the valid obligations incurred for the purpose for which the bonds were issued.

B. It shall be the duty of the ~~Commission~~ Director of the Office of State Finance to promptly certify to the State Treasurer the amount of all sums not needed for payment of construction and other legal expenditures payable from the fund to meet the payment schedule, and upon receipt of such certification the State Treasurer shall forthwith invest such funds.

C. All interest received by the State Treasurer for such investments shall be utilized as determined by the Commission.

SECTION 130. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 1992 (62 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 41.5n), is amended to read as follows:

Section 41.5n A. There is hereby created, to continue until July 1, 1998, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law, Section 3901 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a State Data Processing and Telecommunications Advisory Committee. The Committee shall assist the Office of State Finance in addressing the state's data processing and telecommunications needs. The Committee shall consist of ~~seventeen (17) members, fifteen of whom shall be chief administrative officers of state agencies or their respective designees and two of whom shall be members of the Legislature. One member of the Legislature shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member of the Legislature shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. The following agencies shall maintain permanent representation on the Committee:~~

1. Office of State Finance; twenty-five (25) members, nine of whom shall be voting members and sixteen of whom shall be ex officio

nonvoting members. Voting members shall include three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, three members of the State Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, two members appointed by the Governor, and the Director of the Office of State Finance or the Director's designee. Ex officio nonvoting members shall include the chief administrative officer of each of the following state agencies or his or her designee:

- ~~2.~~ 1. State Department of Education;
- ~~3.~~ 2. Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education;
- ~~4.~~ 3. Department of Public Safety;
- ~~5.~~ 4. Department of Human Services;
- ~~6.~~ 5. Department of Commerce;
- ~~7.~~ 6. Department of Libraries;
- ~~8.~~ 7. Oklahoma Educational Television Authority;
- ~~9.~~ 8. Oklahoma Corporation Commission;
- ~~10.~~ 9. State Department of Vocational and Technical Education;

- ~~12.~~ 11. Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department; ~~and~~
- ~~13.~~ 12. State Department of Health;
13. Oklahoma Tax Commission; and
14. State Election Board.

The remaining two ex officio nonvoting positions shall be rotated among other state agencies at the discretion of the Governor. The chairmanship of the Committee shall alternate every two (2) years ~~between~~ among the House of Representatives ~~and~~, the Senate and the Director of the Office of State Finance at the beginning of each odd-numbered year. Meetings of the Committee shall be called by the Chairman not less than two times each year and shall be open to data processing and telecommunications managers from all state agencies. A majority of the voting members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum.

B. Members of the State Data Processing and Telecommunications Advisory Committee shall receive no ~~additional~~ compensation for serving on the Committee, but shall ~~be reimbursed for any travel in connection with such service by their respective agencies in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ receive travel reimbursement as follows:

1. Legislative members of the Committee shall be reimbursed for their necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

2. Nonlegislative members of the Committee shall be reimbursed by their respective agencies for their necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

~~B.~~ C. The duties of the State Data Processing and Telecommunications Advisory Committee shall include:

1. Advising the Office of State Finance in the development of a statewide master plan for telecommunications and in the development of the Oklahoma Government Telecommunications Network created in Section ~~4~~ 41.5m of this ~~act~~ title;

2. Providing a forum for discussion of major issues facing state agencies in the areas of data processing and telecommunications;

3. Meeting jointly with the Industry Advisory Committee created pursuant to Section 41.5b of ~~Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title at least annually to ensure that the state's planned

activities are consistent with the direction of industry data processing and telecommunications; ~~and~~

4. Advising the Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance on the development and implementation of statewide data processing policies; and

5. Making recommendations to the Office of State Finance for expenditures for telecommunications as provided in Section 57.303 of this title and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution; provided, however, no such recommendations shall become final and no such expenditures shall be made unless approved by the Contingency Review Board.

SECTION 131. The Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is hereby authorized to pursue, and if it deems appropriate, to conduct the refinancing and defeasance of the Series 1972 and 1973 obligations between the effective date of this act and June 30, 1994. For the purposes of this section, the Authority may retain such legal counsel as it deems necessary notwithstanding any other provisions of law.

SECTION 132. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 133. NONCODIFICATION Except for Sections 122, 129 and 130, the provisions of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 134. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
