An Act relating to revenue and taxation;  
amending 68 O.S. 1991, Section 3019, which  
relates to certifying appropriations; modifying  
duties of the county treasurer and secretary of  
the excise board; deleting certain requisition  
requirement; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 1991, Section 3019, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 3019. The secretary of the excise board shall  
immediately certify each appropriation as made by the excise board  
to the clerk or other issuing officer ~~and the treasurer~~ of the  
municipality for which the same is made. The several items of the  
estimate as made and approved by the excise board for each fiscal  
year shall constitute and are hereby declared to be an appropriation  
of funds for the several and specific purposes named in such  
estimate, and the appropriations thus made shall not be used for any  
other fiscal year or purposes whatsoever, except as provided in the  
preceding section. Each clerk or other issuing officer ~~and each~~  
~~treasurer~~ shall open and keep an account for the amount of each item  
of appropriation, showing the purpose for which the same is  
appropriated, and the date, number, and amount of each warrant  
thereon. No warrant or certificate of indebtedness in any form  
shall be issued, approved, signed, or attested, ~~or registered,~~ on or  
against any appropriation for a purpose other than that for which  
the said item of appropriation was made, or in excess of the amount  
thereof.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
