An Act relating to state government; extending
life of certain committee; providing for
noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties, functions, powers and responsibilities
of the Joint Legislative Committee to investigate the operation of
the Developmentally Disabled Unit of the Department of Human
Services created by Senate Joint Resolution No. 16 of the 1st
Session of the 43rd Oklahoma Legislature, are hereby extended until
October 1, 1994.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 shall not be codified in
the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
