An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
21 O.S. 1991, Section 64, which relates to
misdemeanor fines; authorizing a jury to impose
fines under certain circumstances; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1991, Section 64, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 64. A. Upon a conviction for any misdemeanor
punishable by imprisonment in any jail, in relation to which no fine
is herein prescribed, the court or a jury may impose a fine on the
offender not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in addition
to the imprisonment prescribed.

B. Upon a conviction for any felony punishable by imprisonment
in any jail or prison, in relation to which no fine is herein
prescribed, the court or a jury may impose a fine on the offender
not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in addition to the
imprisonment prescribed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
