An Act relating to counties and county officers;
requiring county clerk to keep and maintain certain
records; repealing 19 O.S. 1991, Section 644, which
relates to the county clerk keeping duplicate of
treasurer's cash book; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 644.1 of Title 19, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The county clerk shall keep and maintain, in a safe place, the
duplicate copy of all daily collections and deposits made by the
county treasurer as required by Section 115 of Title 19 of the
Oklahoma Statutes and as furnished to the county clerk by the county
treasurer. The county clerk may keep a separate ledger of said
transaction.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 19 O.S. 1991, Section 644, is hereby
repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
