An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
requiring the Corporation Commission to assemble
data regarding location of fiber optics lines and
cable; requiring report of findings; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 140 of Title 17, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

On or before January 1, 1994, the Corporation Commission shall
assemble all data available regarding the location of all fiber
optics lines and cable used for telecommunications purposes in the
state and report its findings to the Governor, Speaker of the House
of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate and members
of the State Data Processing and Telecommunications Advisory
Committee created pursuant to Section 41.5n of Title 62 of the
Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
