An Act relating to higher education services; making appropriations to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; stating purposes; requiring the transfer of certain funds under certain conditions; stating legislative intent; making appropriations to the Physician Manpower Training Commission; stating purposes; providing budgetary categories; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; authorizing certain expenditure of appropriations regardless of prior purpose; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse date; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution to the institutions of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of One Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Four Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$164,416.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the general operating budget of the Administrative Offices of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 3. As funds become available, the Director of the Office of State Finance shall transfer the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) from the Building Bond Revolving Fund, created pursuant to Section 7 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1091 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature, to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the duties imposed upon the Regents by law.

SECTION 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds available for the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary be allocated and expended by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for the purposes of funding the new start-up and operation costs associated with campus expansions, construction, or other capital improvements which become operational in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, at such institutions as specified pursuant to Section 57.303 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes and Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution. It is further the intent of the Legislature that if the funds transferred in Section 3 of this act are not sufficient to fully fund the purposes set forth in this section, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall reduce the funding in a proportionate amount for each institution which qualifies for the funds.

SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds appropriated in Section 8 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 896 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature for the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that Four Hundred Ninety-four Million Six Hundred Forty-six Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-nine Dollars (\$494,646,289.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary be allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution to the institutions of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds appropriated in Section 9 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 896 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature for the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that Six Million One Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-three Dollars (\$6,157,583.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary be allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution to the institutions of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds appropriated in Section 9 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 896 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature for the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) be allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and transferred to the Oklahoma State Regents' Endowment Trust Fund.

SECTION 8. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds appropriated in Section 9 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 896 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature for the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that Three Million Eight Hundred Forty-two Thousand Four Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$3,842,417.00) be allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and transferred to the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars Trust Fund.

SECTION 9. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds appropriated in Section 10 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 896 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature for the duties

imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that One Million Six Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-three Dollars (\$1,624,583.00) be allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and transferred to the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Scholars Trust Fund.

SECTION 10. It is the intent of the Legislature that of the funds appropriated in Section 10 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 896 of the 2nd Session of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature for the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education by law, that Thirteen Million Three Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Four Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$13,375,417.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary be expended for Oklahoma tuition aid grants pursuant to the Oklahoma Higher Education Tuition Aid Act.

PHYSICIAN MANPOWER TRAINING COMMISSION

SECTION 11. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-six Dollars (\$2,866.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law.

SECTION 12. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the Physician Manpower Training Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories:

SECTION 13. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law shall be set by the Physician Manpower Training Commission. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Forty-three Thousand Nine Hundred Ten Dollars (\$43,910.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Physician Manpower Training Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 14. Funds appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission in Sections 1 and 2, Chapter 354, O.S.L. 1993,

may be budgeted and expended for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, and may be budgeted and expended for the general operating expenses of the Physician Manpower Training Commission regardless of the purpose for which the funds were budgeted by the agency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994.

SECTION 15. The appropriations made by Sections 1 and 2 of this act and the transfer made in Section 3 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 16. The appropriation made by Section 11 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1995. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1995, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 17. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.
