An Act relating to law enforcement officers;
amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1289.8, which
relates to carrying concealed weapons;
authorizing certain officers to carry sidearms
upon retirement; requiring such officers to
obtain certain training certification; directing
the Commissioner of Public Safety to promulgate
certain rules, regulations and procedures; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1289.8, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 1289.8 A. It shall be unlawful for any person, except
a law enforcement officer, a retired state or federal peace officer
as provided in subsection B of this section, a registered security
officer or a person employed by an armored car firm licensed by the
Corporation Commission, to carry a concealed weapon other than
permitted by this act.

B. Any retiring state or federal peace officer may carry a
concealed sidearm upon written approval from the Commissioner of
Public Safety, provided such officer has no physical or mental
disability which would prevent the proper handling of the sidearm.
Such persons must have been C.L.E.E.T. certified or certified by a
law enforcement training program recognized by C.L.E.E.T. Such
persons must then qualify annually by a C.L.E.E.T.-approved firearms
training program at their own expense. The Commissioner of Public
Safety shall promulgate rules, regulations and procedures relating
to application and approval to carry a sidearm upon retirement.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
