An Act relating to poor persons; providing for establishment and maintenance of a community-based program of services; providing for administration; providing for duties; providing for gifts; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1020 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Director of the Department of Human Services shall, within the constraints of funding appropriated to the Department, establish and maintain a community-based program of services, including but not limited to establishment of foster care and supported living arrangements for victims of Prader-Willi syndrome.

B. The program established pursuant to this section shall be administered by the Developmental Disabilities Service Division. The Department shall undertake to identify and utilize any and all federal funding which may be available for such services.

C. The Department is authorized to accept any gift of real or personal property made for the use or benefit of any program or services established pursuant to this section. Such gift may only be utilized for the purpose or purposes for which it is given.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
