An Act relating to appropriations to the State Election Board; making an appropriation to the State Election Board; providing salary increases for County Election Board Secretaries; providing that provisions supersede certain laws; making appropriation nonfiscal.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Fifty-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$57,700.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Election Board.

SECTION 2. Effective October 1, 1994, all County Election Board Secretaries shall be awarded an annualized salary increase of Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) per year above the salary amount in effect on September 30, 1994. Such salary increase shall be made regardless of any salary limitation provided in Section 2-118 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.
