AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
allowing counties to maintain erroneous maps and  
highway designations under certain circumstances;  
providing for Department of Transportation to  
recognize certain maps and designations; providing  
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 653.1 of Title 69, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any county which relies on an incorrect map which numerically  
designates each section line in this state as provided for in  
Section 653 of this title, in preparing official county maps and  
classifying and designating the various routes comprising the county  
road system in accordance with Section 654 of this title, and in  
placing or erecting markers in accordance with Section 655 of this  
title, may continue to use said maps, designations, and markers,  
even though erroneous, until suitable funds are available to change  
the maps, designations and markers. The state shall recognize the  
erroneous designations of the county until such time the changes are  
made.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
