AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety;

providing for certain reciprocal agreements between ambulance service providers; establishing certain terms for reciprocal agreements; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2514 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All persons, companies, governmental entities or trust authorities operating an ambulance service in this state shall enter into and make reciprocal compacts and agreements with other ambulance service providers. Such compacts and agreements shall provide that any person who pays or contracts for ambulance service within their particular area shall not be charged by another ambulance service if that person is required under this act or otherwise to utilize an ambulance service outside of their particular area. The charge for such service shall be included as part of the ambulance service agreement with the individual paying for the service within their area.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
