HOUSE BILL NO. 1241

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; requiring the Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management to develop a uniform policy for shift differential; providing for hazardous duty pay; requiring administrative rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840.16e of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall develop and publish a uniform policy for shift differential for all state employees working shifts that are outside of the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. The policy shall establish a minimum rate for shift differential and shall pertain to all state agencies.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840.16f of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. All state employees who engage in hazardous employment shall be compensated by hazardous duty pay at the rate of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per month for each year of state service. Such compensation

shall be in addition to any longevity pay authorized pursuant to Section 805.2 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. The Administrator of the Office of Personnel Management shall promulgate such rules as are necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
