HOUSE BILL NO. 1300

AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1310, which relates to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Act; modifying appropriation procedure for the group insurance plans; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1310, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1310. ~~A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, each state agency participating in the Group Insurance Plans~~ The Legislature shall appropriate ~~and pay~~ to the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board for deposit in the appropriate reserve fund an amount to be set by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board for each employee other than education employees per month enrolled in ~~said the Group Insurance Plans, from funds appropriated to said agency or from other funds available to such agency for operational purposes.~~

~~B. During the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, each state agency participating in the Group Insurance Plans shall appropriate and pay to the State Employees Group Insurance Clearing Fund an amount to be set by the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board for each employee other than education employees per month enrolled in said Plans, from funds appropriated to said agency or from other funds available to such agency for operational purposes.~~

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1993.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
