AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to marriage and family; providing for certain modifications of child support; specifying conditions; providing for payment of attorney fees; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 110.1 of Title 43, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In any action for modification of an order for payment of additional child support brought by the custodial parent, attorney fees for such action shall be awarded to the noncustodial parent if the court finds that the action was:

1. Frivolous;
2. Brought without reasonable basis; or
3. Brought for purposes of harassment or retaliation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
