HOUSE BILL NO. 1667

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; establishing the Psychological Services Division within the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; transferring the Department of Public Safety Director of Psychological Services and one secretary II from Department of Public Safety to Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, subject to certain conditions; transferring certain items from the Department of Public Safety to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; repealing 47 O.S. 1992, Section 2-133, which relates to Department of Public Safety authorization for a Psychological Services Division; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.29 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby established in the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation a Division to be known as the Psychological Services

Division. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall appoint a Director of Psychological Services and employ such clerical, support personnel and interns on a full-time or part-time basis as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Division. The persons employed as of June 30, 1993, by the Department of Public Safety as the Director of Psychological Services and the Secretary II assigned to the Psychological Services Division pursuant to Section 2-133 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

B. All Department of Public Safety vehicles, equipment, furniture, supplies, library resource materials, and any other items used by the transferred employees shall be transferred to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation with the transferred employees.

C. All transferred Department of Public Safety employees shall be employed by Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation subject to successful completion of Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation's entrance requirements, including background investigation.

D. The Psychological Services Division shall, among other duties, provide counseling services to Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation employees, employment screening, profiling of violent crimes, and assistance to other law enforcement agencies as determined by the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-133, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1993.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
