HOUSE BILL NO. 1671

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; making an appropriation thereto; stating purpose; making appropriation nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to renovate property leased by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the effective date of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1993.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
