AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; stating legislative intent concerning the enrollment of certain persons in institutions of higher education in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3229 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Legislature that any resident of Oklahoma who has received a high school diploma may enroll in any institution of higher education in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education regardless of any other admissions standard or entrance requirement, except for the payment of required fees, specified by the Board of Regents governing that institution or by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
