HOUSE BILL NO. 1909

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 2-132, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 316, O.S.L. 1993 (26 O.S. Supp. 1993, Section 2-132), which relates to disqualification of election board members; changing resignation requirement for disqualified board members; providing for a replacement in certain circumstances; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 2-132, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 316, O.S.L. 1993 (26 O.S. Supp. 1993, Section 2-132), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-132. No person shall serve on a county election board, precinct election board, absentee voting board or as a counter for a precinct election board, at any election in which he is a candidate for office, is a deputy or regular employee of a candidate for office or is related within the third degree by either consanguinity or affinity to a candidate for office. In the event a member of a precinct election board is disqualified for one of the aforementioned reasons, it shall be the duty of the secretary of the

county election board to appoint a suitable replacement for the official for said election. Any person so disqualified shall ~~resign his office or position no later than ten (10) days following the close of the filing period during which such candidacy was filed~~ not participate in or carry out any duties or functions associated with the office or position during said election. If necessary, the Secretary of the State Election Board shall appoint a replacement to carry out the duties or functions of the office for said election.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
