HOUSE BILL NO. 2173

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 18c-2, which relates to the Attorney General; modifying procedure for disqualification determinations regarding the Office of the Attorney General; providing for notice to Attorney General; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 18c-2, is amended to read as follows:

Section 18c-2. ~~Any~~ If any state agency ~~which~~ requires legal representation for itself or any employee and there appears to be a conflict of interest in that representation by the Attorney General's Office as determined by the ~~Attorney General~~ affected agency, then the agency shall have the authority to retain alternate counsel to supplement or replace the representation provided by the Attorney General's Office. The chief administrative officer of the affected agency shall advise the Attorney General in writing of the determination to supplement or replace the representation provided by the Attorney General. Provided that this section shall not apply

to agencies authorized by statute to have an attorney. Said counsel shall be paid from the budget of the retaining agency.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
