HOUSE BILL NO. 2329

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of Personnel

Management; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 840.5b, which relates to the Certified Public Managers Revolving Fund; modifying name of fund; authorizing deposit of other monies; providing exceptions to monies authorized for deposit; modifying purpose for which monies may be expended from fund; providing for transfer of unexpended and unencumbered balance; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 840.5b, is amended to read as follows:

Section 840.5b There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Office of Personnel Management to be designated the "~~Certified Public Managers~~ Office of Personnel Management Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of fees received by the Office of Personnel Management for providing training for a certified public managers program and all other monies received by the Office of Personnel Management, except for

appropriated monies, monies received as payment for administrative expenses under Section 840.14 of this title, monies placed in the Employee Benefits Revolving Fund, monies placed in the Benefits Council Administration Revolving Fund, and any monies in revolving funds established by the Office of State Finance to support the operation of the Oklahoma Employee Benefits Council or to reimburse the Office of Personnel Management for services the Office provides to the Council. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of Personnel Management for ~~a certified public managers program~~ the purpose of paying the costs incurred in performing the duties and functions of the Office. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 1994, all unexpended, unencumbered or otherwise unobligated monies remaining in the Certified Manager Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 840.5b of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to the credit of the Office of Personnel Management Revolving Fund created in Section 840.5b of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
