AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to property; providing that certain landowners own property to center of certain roads and streets; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 350 of Title 60, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Unless otherwise provided in any deed of conveyance or by law, the owner of any land which abuts, adjoins or is bounded by any road or street, which is privately maintained but dedicated for public use, and which is not owned or has not been accepted by any county or municipality shall be deemed to own to the center of the road or street for any purposes, including taxation of such property.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
