AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to waters and water rights; changing
the name of the North Canadian River to the
Oklahoma River; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 526.4 of Title 82, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law or in violation of
the Canadian River Compact, Section 526.1 of Title 82 of the
Oklahoma Statutes, the part of the Canadian River which flows from
Woodward County in Oklahoma through the State of Oklahoma
terminating in Lake Eufaula, referred to as the North Canadian
River, shall hereinafter be known as the "Oklahoma River". All
references to the North Canadian River flowing through Oklahoma, as
specified in this section, shall mean the Oklahoma River.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
