AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to children; requiring determination and payment of child support in certain court actions; requiring certain findings of fact; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21.2 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In any court action in which provision is made for the custody of a minor child, the court shall determine and provide for the payment of child support for such minor child pursuant to child support guidelines specified by Sections 118 and 119 of Title 43 of the Oklahoma Statutes. If the court determines that child support is not required, it shall make specific findings of fact supporting such action.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
