AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public records and information;
making an appropriation to the Secretary of State;
stating purpose; making an appropriation to the
State Department of Libraries; stating purpose;
providing lapse dates; providing an effective date;
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Secretary of State by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much

thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1995. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1995, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
