AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Merit Protection Commission;
providing budgetary limitations; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Merit Protection Commission by law shall be set by the Executive Director of the Merit Protection Commission. The salary of the Executive Director of the Merit Protection Commission shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Merit Protection Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
