AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Water Resources

Board; making an appropriation thereto; prohibiting
certain usage; providing for duties and
compensation of employees; setting maximum salary
of Executive Director; establishing budgetary
limitations; making certain full-time-equivalent
employees contingent on certain funding; providing
an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA WATER RESOURCES BOARD

SECTION 1. Of the funds appropriated by Section _____,
the sum of _____ Dollars (\$_____.00) shall be used for the
purpose of providing contractual services with the Oklahoma Rural
Water Association, to provide technical assistance and training to
rural water system operators. No part of these funds can be used to
pay any portion of the compensation of the Oklahoma Rural Water
Association Executive Director.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Fifty-nine Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$59,661.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. Of the ____ (__) full-time-equivalent employee positions authorized in Section __ of this act, ____ (__) full-time-equivalent employee positions shall be filled contingent upon receipt of Federal Clean Lakes Program grant funds as authorized in Section 314 of the Federal Clean Water Act.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
