AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prevention of discriminatory  
treatment related agencies; making appropriations  
thereto; specifying purposes; providing an  
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission on  
Children and Youth from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 1995, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Commission on Children and Youth by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
Handicapped Concerns from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 1995, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Office of Handicapped Concerns by law.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Human Rights Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Human Rights Commission by law.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Indian Affairs Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Indian Affairs Commission by law.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
