AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to chief executive offices; making appropriations to the Office of the Governor; stating purposes; making appropriations to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor; stating purposes; making appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

GOVERNOR

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of One Million Seven Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$1,727,665.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Governor by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00), or

so much thereof as may be necessary for payment of official and necessary maintenance expenses for the mansion pursuant to Section 7 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-four Dollars (\$14,884.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for Personal Services. Funds appropriated by this section may be budgeted and expended only after the agency has complied with the provisions for implementing the FY-95 State Salary Pay Increase Plan.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for expenses associated with transition duties within the Office of the Governor.

LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the amount of Three Hundred Thirty-one Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$331,960.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Lieutenant Governor by law.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$3,880.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for Personal Services. Funds appropriated by this section may be

budgeted and expended only after the agency has complied with the provisions for implementing the FY-95 State Salary Pay Increase Plan.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for expenses associated with transition duties within the Office of the Lieutenant Governor.

SECTION 8. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
