AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution requesting initial orientation and continuing education programs for certain judges; requesting that the training be provided through existing programs; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, juvenile law and domestic relations law are continually modified to reflect the changing conditions and needs of society; and

WHEREAS, juvenile and domestic relations cases involve complex issues that require judicial expertise with a special emphasis in juvenile and domestic relations law; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain this specialized expertise to facilitate handling juvenile and domestic relations cases; and

WHEREAS, the judiciary has expressed interest in receiving continuing training in these areas of the law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION 1. It is the request of the Legislature that the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court provide by rule or by order for a program of initial orientation and a program of continuing education for judges of the district court having substantial

juvenile or domestic relations docket responsibilities. The curriculum for the orientation and the continuing education programs should include, but not be limited to, training in juvenile law and procedures, domestic relations law and procedures, family dynamics, spousal abuse and domestic violence issues, child abuse and neglect issues, and the children and youth service system as defined by Section 600 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. It is the request of the Legislature that the training programs provided for in Section 1 of this resolution should be provided through existing state judicial conferences and seminars authorized by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court.

SECTION 3. A copy of this resolution shall be dispatched to the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court.
