AS INTRODUCED

WHEREAS, Harper Vincent Orth has been honored many times throughout his lifetime including being named to "Who's Who in the South and Southwest", named as a Personality of the South, named Father of the Year in Shawnee, Oklahoma and named the Outstanding Rotarian of Norman; and

WHEREAS, Harper Vincent Orth has served the State of Oklahoma in his current position as Chairman of the Cerebral Palsy Commission, with his prior position as Administrative Director of the J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities in Norman, as a member of the Board of Directors of United Cerebral Palsy of Oklahoma, Inc., a past member of the United Cerebral Palsy

National Board of Directors, as a past chairman of the Professional Services Advisory Board - United Cerebral Palsy of Oklahoma, and continues his memberships in various organizations including the Oklahoma Developmental Disability Council; and

WHEREAS, Harper Vincent Orth has earned these awards and appointments by demonstrating his commitment and dedication to serving the needs of those afflicted with cerebral palsy, and by providing leadership and inspiration to his community; and

WHEREAS, Harper Vincent Orth is now retiring from his thirty-seven dedicated years of service to cerebral palsy victims and their families.
