A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Oklahoma Historical Society on its centennial; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, in 1993, the Oklahoma Historical Society celebrates its 100th anniversary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
