HOUSE CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION NO. 1062

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution expressing legislative intent that the State Board of Education develop certain policies relating to community education; providing that such policies should encourage school districts to utilize funding resources for community education programs; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature has removed line-item funding of community education from the common schools appropriation bill (HB 1818); and

WHEREAS, the legislative intent is not to eliminate community education from the public schools of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, funds earmarked for community education previously limited funding through competitive grants to a small number of school districts; and

WHEREAS, these previously set-aside dollars will now flow to all Oklahoma school districts through the funding formula; and

WHEREAS, community education can provide cost-effective lifelong learning opportunities and enhance the quality of life for all Oklahomans;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature expresses its intent that the State Board of Education develop policies that will encourage school districts

to utilize their funding resources to establish, maintain, and expand cost-effective community education programs.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the State Board of Education.
