AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to joint rules; creating a new joint rule concerning committee hearings; and requiring committees to consider measures under certain circumstances.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION 1. A new joint rule to be designated as Joint Rule 27, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The principal author of any engrossed measure assigned to a committee in the house opposite the house of origin shall be entitled to have the measure considered by a vote of the committee prior to any committee hearing deadline adopted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. In order to require the committee to consider the measure, the principal author of the measure must make a written request for a hearing. The written request must be received by the chair of the committee at least one (1) week prior to the committee hearing deadline specified in Joint Rule 17. As used in this rule, "measure" means a bill, joint resolution or concurrent resolution.
