HOUSE CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION NO. 1094

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to proposed fee increases by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission; stating legislative intent that there be no fee increases; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission has proposed increasing fees for the use of state park facilities in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature finds these fee increases to be unnecessarily burdensome on the citizens of this state; and

WHEREAS, America was founded on the peoples' right to enjoy this country's natural resources; and

WHEREAS, historically Oklahomans have cherished and treasured this state's bountiful natural resources; and

WHEREAS, any additional fees inhibit the opportunities for Oklahomans to enjoy these resources; and

WHEREAS, while acknowledging that agencies must at times consider increasing fees to help pay for the services they provide, it is nonetheless right and proper that the Oklahoma Legislature work to protect the rights of the people of the State of Oklahoma to enjoy the state's protected resources at affordable rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature opposes any fee increases proposed by the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation for the recreational use of state park facilities.

THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission.
