WHEREAS, the dedicated current and retired employees of Griffin Memorial Hospital have long provided compassionate care and treatment for persons experiencing the devastation of mental illness; and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 1994, Griffin Memorial Hospital is celebrating a "Century of Dedication to People".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT May 20, 1994, be proclaimed "Griffin Memorial Hospital Day"
in the State of Oklahoma in recognition of past service to the
citizens of Oklahoma and in anticipation of continued service and
compassion for the mentally ill.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,
the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, the
Administrative Director of the Griffin Memorial Hospital and the
Mayor of the City of Norman, Oklahoma.
