AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution clarifying legislative intent concerning the mandatory pay increase for classified employees; providing for certain lump-sum payments; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, clarification is needed to effectuate the intent of the Legislature concerning the mandatory pay increase for classified state employees provided for in Section 23, Chapter 367, O.S.L. 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. For purposes of the mandatory pay increase for classified employees provided for in Section 23, Chapter 367, O.S.L. 1992, the one-step pay increase shall be deemed to be an increase in pay of two and one-half percent (2 1/2%) beginning on the payroll date of the month after this resolution becomes effective, regardless of an employee's position on the salary schedule. Classified employees who received a mandatory one-step pay increase pursuant to Section 23, Chapter 367, O.S.L. 1992, shall receive a lump-sum payment for the difference between a one-step increase and a two and one-half percent (2 1/2%) increase for those months

beginning December 1, 1992, through the month this resolution becomes effective.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
