AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution disapproving rules of the State Board of Cosmetology relating to licensure of cosmetologists, schools and related establishments; directing distribution; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 250.2 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to determine that a rule is not consistent with legislative intent, establish policy and designate the method for rule promulgation; and

WHEREAS, the rule impact statement was not in substantial compliance with Section 303 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor, the State Board of Cosmetology and the Office of Administrative Rules.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
