AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution declaring March 7 through 13, 1993, as Save Your Vision Week; and directing distribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives join with the President of the United States in proclaiming the week of March 7 through 13, 1993, as Save Your Vision Week.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives urges the citizens of Oklahoma to carefully consider their eye care needs during this time for their own well-being and for the good of the state.

THAT doctors of optometry, other health care professionals, community leaders, schools, businesses and the media unite in a concerted effort to better educate the citizens of the great State of Oklahoma about the importance of eye care.
