AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution urging the President of the United States and the United States Congress to make spending cuts before raising taxes; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the United States has a new President; and

WHEREAS, the United States has a new Congress in 1993; and

WHEREAS, many newly elected officials, including the President, made central to their campaigns the issue of reducing the National Debt; and

WHEREAS, unnecessary entitlements and excessive waste and fraud are rampant within the Federal Government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives strongly urges the President of the United States and the United States Congress to make spending cuts before considering raising any new taxes, whether they be direct or indirect.

THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the President of the United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, each member of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation, and the other forty-nine states' Legislative bodies urging them to send similar resolutions.
