AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to the support of the General Aviation Revitalization Act of 1993; encouraging the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation to actively support the act; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress is contemplating the passage of the General Aviation Revitalization Act of 1993, which would establish a fifteen-year statute of repose for general aviation and business aircraft and component parts manufacturers; and

WHEREAS, this federal legislation would end the dramatic decline in the light aircraft industry and would create thousands of well-paying jobs in manufacturing, engineering, and support positions over a five-year period at no cost to the government; and

WHEREAS, new career opportunities would be created for young people; and

WHEREAS, aviation manufacturers in the United States would regain the worldwide leadership in the production of aircraft; and

WHEREAS, new training aircraft would enter the marketplace; and

WHEREAS, exports of the United States would increase; and

WHEREAS, general aviation manufacturers have publicly stated their intentions to begin production upon passage of the federal act; and

WHEREAS, the federal legislation has broad-based support from the Airline Commission, as well as every general aviation consumer group and the International Association of Machinists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives, representing the public trust of the citizens of Oklahoma, supports the passage of the General Aviation Revitalization Act of 1993.

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Transportation Subcommittee on Aeronautics and Railways strongly encourage the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation to actively support this act.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to all members of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.
