AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution relating to the House Rules; amending House Rule No. 8 of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature by adding a new Section 10, which relates to introduction of measures; limiting number of measures a member of the House of Representatives may introduce; and defining term.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. House Rule No. 8 of the 44th Oklahoma Legislature is amended by adding a new Section 10 to read as follows:

Section 10. No member of the House shall introduce more than ten (10) measures during a session of the Legislature. As used in this section, "measures" means bills and joint resolutions that do not contain appropriation matters.
