AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 7003, which relates to the Oklahoma State Employee Charitable Contribution Act; clarifying reference to act; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 7003, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7003. As used in the Oklahoma State Employee Charitable Contribution Act, Section 7001 et seq. of this title:

1. "Federation" means a legally constituted grouping of at least five health and social service agencies that are bound together to raise and distribute charitable contributions;

2. "Geographic area" means a county or the area encompassed by counties or portions of counties which have combined for the purpose of conducting a local Oklahoma State Employee Charitable Contribution Campaign;

3. "Local federation" means a federation that provides direct service in a specific geographic area in this state;

4. "Local presence" means a test to determine whether the agency actually provides service to people in the geographic area and whether said geographic area has any input into the service provision process;

5. "Local state agency review committee" means a group of state employees in a geographic area who are responsible for overseeing the actual solicitation of state employees in their geographic area;

6. "Loaned executive" means an employee paid by a local company, organization or agency who is released by his or her employer to assist in running a local charitable contribution campaign;

7. "Principal combined fund raising organization" means the organization in each of the geographic areas responsible for the charitable contribution campaign; and

8. "State Agency Review Committee" means a group of state employees responsible for overseeing at the state level the conducting of the Oklahoma State Employees Charitable Contribution Campaign.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
