AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending  
74 O.S. 1991, Section 217, which relates to the State  
Auditor and Inspector; clarifying statutory  
reference; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 217, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 217. If by reason of sickness, absence or other cause,  
the State Auditor and Inspector is temporarily unable to perform the  
duties of his office the said assistant shall perform the duties of  
the office of State Auditor and Inspector until such disability  
ceases, whenever the same will not be inconsistent with the  
Constitution.

The State Auditor and Inspector, and his clerical and  
stenographic assistants, shall be reimbursed actual and necessary  
travel expenses when traveling on official state business as  
provided by the State Travel Reimbursement Act, Section 500.1 et  
seq. of this title.

If said State Auditor and Inspector, or any deputy, or employee,  
shall at any time, directly or indirectly receive compensation for  
his service, or neglect of service, other than that provided for in  
this article, he shall be deemed guilty of a felony. The making of  
a false report knowingly by the State Auditor and Inspector, or any

assistant or deputy, authorized by this article, of the financial condition of any office or institution required or authorized to be examined by this article, shall constitute a felony, and any failure to perform the duties required of them to be performed by this article shall constitute a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
